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Basic and Contextual Information

Chichester District Council has 13% of the pupils of West Sussex in 20% of West Sussex schools.

27% of its schools are academies which account for 16% of West Sussex children and young people in the District.

Vulnerable children and young people

Vulnerable pupils are defined as those who have statements of Special Educational Needs, English as an additional language, Black and Minority Ethnic Groups, those receiving Free School Meals, service children, and Looked After Children. Chichester District Council is a relatively affluent area of the county but with pockets of higher deprivation. It has a higher proportion of statemented children but does have 30% of the county special schools (in which all children are statemented). It is at the county average for those children and young people in receipt of Free School Meals and for the proportion of Looked After Children

The absence rate in Chichester District Council schools is higher than the county average and particularly high in the Chichester locality. However, it should be noted that Chichester locality has three special schools which have higher absence rates than mainstream schools as there will be more children and young people with illness and health issues linked to their medical conditions.

Collaboration and locality work for vulnerable pupils

The Learning Service has encouraged localities to collaborate on projects that will impact on learning outcomes for children and young people in their area. Locality funding has been made available to support this work. An example of this collaboration is the work by schools in the Chichester locality to jointly commission their own Primary Health Worker.

Other identified needs in the area include the need for support in Early Years and pre-school settings for the rising numbers of children with English as an additional language. The EMAT (Ethnic Minority and Traveller) team works closely with settings to support these children.

Following the demise of the Connexions universal careers service, Secondary schools are looking at ways of working on this collaboratively with FE colleges.

Outcome Data

Key Stage 2 key indicators

- The key DfE threshold indicator for identifying underperforming schools is those schools that achieve below 60% at L4+ in English and mathematics.
- Ofsted focus on performance in relation to the national average (in line, below or above) for L4+ E/M and to national expectations for two levels of progress in English and in mathematics by the end of KS2.
- A further benchmark is used by WSCC – Fischer Family Trust (FFT) data. FFT data is based on an analysis of national data and produces estimates of progress that children should make based on their prior attainment at the previous Key Stage.
- FFT 'B' estimates compares each pupil to pupils nationally with the same prior attainment and FFT 'D' estimates compare each pupil with the progress made by the top 25%.

The data in the table below shows the collated averages for each district and West Sussex against the national data for the key indicator and for the two progress measures. There are four years of data included to give an indication of trend over a period of time.

This data shows that Chichester District Council performs well above threshold measures.

This data also shows that in 2012 the schools in Chichester District Council and the county for the first time for 4 years exceeded FFT 'B' and the national average and national expectations for progress.

- The district is close to the West Sussex average and the national average and are on average well above the floor threshold.
- In the previous 4 years both West Sussex and Chichester District Council have been below the national average.
- However there has been a much improved picture in 2012 with West Sussex moving to the national average and Chichester District Council exceeding the national average on the key indicator.
- Primary pupils in the district are making better progress this year and are exceeding the FFT 'B' estimates.
- There are two schools below the threshold and one of these is now an academy and the other has a very small cohort (11). The Learning Service is working with the DfE to ensure appropriate support can be given to schools with small cohorts. Two projects linked to teaching schools are in hand.
- A further three schools are below 70% and have been included in a project based on brokering school to school support.
- Over 30% of the primary schools exceed the national average by more than 10%.
- The Learning Service encourages schools to aim at FFT 'D' estimates.

Key Stage 4 Key Indicators

- The current DfE threshold for identifying underperforming schools in those schools achieving below 40% for 5+ A*-C at GCSE including English and mathematics. This threshold will be raised to 50% in 2013.
- The Ofsted focus is on performance in relation to the national average 5+ A*-C at GCSE including English and mathematics and on the national expectation for 3 levels of progress in English and in mathematics by the end of KS4.
- FFT data is also used by WSCC with secondary schools. FFT 'B' data compares individual pupils with national rates of progress for pupils of similar prior attainment and FFT 'D' data compares their progress with pupils nationally whose progress is in the top 25%.

This data shows that secondary schools in Chichester District Council perform generally above national average and national expectations but do not perform at expected levels with respect to FFT estimates.

For school data see appendix 4 - page 15

The data indicates that there was an upward trend in the key measures for Key Stage 4 over the last few years but Chichester District Council schools have not made the same rate of improvement as the schools in other areas or districts. There are nine schools with secondary age children and young people and of these three are special schools.

In the mainstream schools:

- Only the Academy Selsey has been below the current threshold over the last four years and this year reached the floor.
- Bishop Luffa has been consistently above the national average and this year Midhurst Rother College and Chichester High School for Boys are above the national average.
- In previous years Chichester High School for Girls has been above the national average.
- All schools have been below the FFT 'B' estimates over the last four years which contrasts with other areas of the county.
