Appendix 1 – Draft Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Policy and Conditions

Section 25 (Closed-circuit Television (CCTV) in Licensed Vehicles) is amended to read:

This Licensing Authority views the installation of overt CCTV recording equipment within Licensed Vehicles as a positive measure in prevention and detection of crime, particularly in protecting drivers from the risk of assault. Furthermore, sound (only activated in the event of an incident, otherwise mute) and image recordings are good evidence if allegations are made against drivers. Where a CCTV system is installed, the Licence Holder(s) must, as Data Controller, ensure that any information captured is processed and stored in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations and Data Protection Act 2018.⁵²

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
