Decision details	 The Local Authority Housing Fund is a new scheme set up by the government to provide long term housing for refugees from Ukraine & Afghanistan. The Council has been allocated £2.68m to deliver 18 units of accommodation with a target delivery date of November 2023. In order to meet this timeframe the recommended delivery model is to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with a Registered Provider(s) of social housing. In the absence of a Cabinet meeting officers be authorised to proceed with the Local Authority Housing Fund as follows: - Approval is given for officers to submit the necessary verification and to sign the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Department for Levelling up Housing and Communities (DLUHC) to participate in the scheme. To accept grant funding of £2.68 m to fund the delivery of affordable housing units that meet the scheme criteria for the specified cohort. That delegated powers are given to the Director of Housing and Communities, following consultation with the Cabinet Member for Housing, Communications, Licensing and Events, to spend the funds in accordance with the grant conditions, to enter into a MOU with a Registered Provider(s) of Social housing to deliver the scheme and agree a lettings scheme in accordance with the scheme prospectus.
