Comment:05/08/2021 8:51 PM The rear outdoor area of proposed establishment is less than 3 metres away from the end of Orchard Way, with several properties backing directly on to the gardens. There were issues with patrons of the previous establishment at this address (Pizza Express), with customers climbing on to and over the brick wall, screaming and shouting loudly (using foul language) and causing a nuisance to the residents of 1 - 4 Egremont Mews [REDACTED] in particular, many of whom are either families with young children, or older people. The concern with a license so late, which is not in keeping with the rest of the area, and totally inappropriate considering the concentration of residential dwellings in such close proximity is that this type of behaviour will be even worse, and later into the night causing great stress and anxiety to local residents. With many of us now working from home, having noise coming from the garden from 8:30am in the morning until 12:30am the next day is simply unacceptable. Orchard Way is also a private road and a quiet residential street, and there is also concern that there will be unauthorised parking of vehicles by the patrons of this new establishment. We believe that an outdoor license in particular should only be permitted until 10pm weekdays and Saturdays as per the previous license at Pizza Express and match the REDH Haslemere Sunday license limit of 16:00 to allow the residents or the surrounding streets a degree of peace and protection from noise and anti-social behaviour that late night alcohol consumption encourages.
