PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER

DRAFT

Chichester District Council (the Council) in exercise of the power under Section 59 of The Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing 2014 (the Act), being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 59 of the Act have been met, makes the following order:

The Order applies to the public areas shown delineated by the red line on the plan annexed to this Order (the 'Restricted Area'):

- a) No person shall refuse to stop drinking alcohol or hand over any container(s) (sealed or unsealed) which are believed to contain alcohol, when required, to do so by an authorised officer in order to prevent public nuisance or disorder.
- b) No person trading as a pedlar shall:
 - I. Remain in any location for more than 10 (ten) minutes unless it is to make a transaction;
 - II. Locate themselves within 50 (fifty) metres of their previous location;
 - III. Return to any location already occupied in the last 3 (three hours);
 - IV. Obstruct the highway or shop entrances.

Any person who, without reasonable excuse, fails to comply with the requirements of this Order commits an offence and shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine note exceeding Level 3 on the standard scale.
