Mr Dicker asked the following supplementary question:

How many comments were made on the Preferred Approach Plan and what is the council doing to address these valid concerns?

The following supplementary responses were provided:

Response 1:

We received 15 responses which related to the quality or legibility of the document and queries regarding questions of fact. The comments regarding different standards for land suitability are not recognised, but it is the case that the number of responses received with regards to proposed allocations in the vicinity of the harbour were:

Policy AL7 (Highgrove Farm, Bosham): Respondents 90, Representations 94

Policy AL8 (East Wittering Parish): Respondents 41, Representations 43

Policy AL9 (Fishbourne Parish): Respondents 104, Representations 123

Policy AL10 (Chidham and Hambrook): Respondents 53, Representations 59

Policy AL12 (Selsey): Respondents 29, Representations 32

The Council is undertaking further work to address these concerns as outlined in the 'Way Forward' report and Council response document.

Response 2:

I can confirm that the Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment was produced in accordance with national planning policy and guidance of the time and that no undue weight has been placed on considerations in different parts of the district. Whilst consideration was given to the potential impact of a site upon the setting of the South Downs National Park, no boundary exclusion was applied to the assessment of the sites within the vicinity of the South Downs National Park.
